

Minnesota insurance law requires the following information to be provided and left with the client at the time of application for life insurance solicitations in Minnesota.

Unless the client personally knows the identity of the insurer and has awareness of their insurance business, or if the client initiated the contact, or if the initial personal contact is made by telephone, or if the attempted sale takes place at the agent's place of business, the agent must provide the following before a personal insurance solicitation:

Name of person who initiated the contact for the solicitation:

The producer, general agency or insurer represented by the agent: \_\_\_\_\_

Please be advised that agent, agency or insurer is in the business of conducting insurance.
